STAT SHEET

- In 2007 there were 3,191 collisions, 836 injuries and 10 fatal collisions involving teens in Northern Ky counties.
- Nationally, one out of four motor vehicle collisions involve a teen age driver (NHTSA)
- In 2006, teen drivers accounted for 26,842 collisions in Kentucky. Of that figure, there were 6,146 injuries and 127 fatalities.
- There were 3,108 (first offense DUI charges for drivers between the ages of 16-19 in Kentucky. There were 120 second offense charges.
- Six percent of all drivers in Kentucky are between the ages of 16-19. This age group accounts for 20% of all injury collisions and 15% of all fatal collisions.
- On an average day in the United States, 10 teenagers are killed in teen-driven vehicles.
