All persons selected for employment by the Kentucky State Police as Cadet Troopers will be subject to a rigorous training program of twenty-three (23) weeks in duration or eleven (11) weeks if an accelerated class is available and you qualify. All cadets are required to live at the Academy during this training period and must adhere to all rules and regulations of the Kentucky State Police. Cadets will be appointed to the position of Trooper upon successful completion of the training program. Initial duty assignments will be made according to the needs of the Kentucky State Police. Officers may be assigned anywhere within Kentucky and may be subject to transfer at any time while employed in a sworn State Police position to any part of the state. Employment may be terminated with or without cause at any time during the training period or the probationary period of one (1) year immediately following appointment as a Trooper. All candidates who are selected for final employment consideration are required to provide a sample (blood/urine) for drug testing purposes. If employed as a sworn officer, submission to random drug testing will be mandatory during the course of employment. Additionally, polygraph examinations will be administered to candidates who are selected for final employment consideration.
